Thank you for your interest in reconstructing North Wallace Avenue. Since our last correspondence our contractors have been surveying and we've secured engineering design services for the project (KLJ Inc. has been selected). We're now ready to begin working with you to develop a design that we can bid early next year and hopefully construct next summer. A proposed project schedule has been attached for your review.

We want to work with you to develop a project that will serve the needs of the transportation system and enhance your neighborhood. To obtain your feedback throughout the design, we're proposing a series of public meetings, starting with a kickoff meeting on October 1, 2015 from 5:30 to 7:30 pm at City Hall (Commission Room). At that meeting, we'll outline the project schedule and our team will present some ideas for traffic calming and other design details. Most importantly, we want to hear from you about your ideas and concerns. In future meetings, we'll incorporate your input and develop a final design by early 2015.
